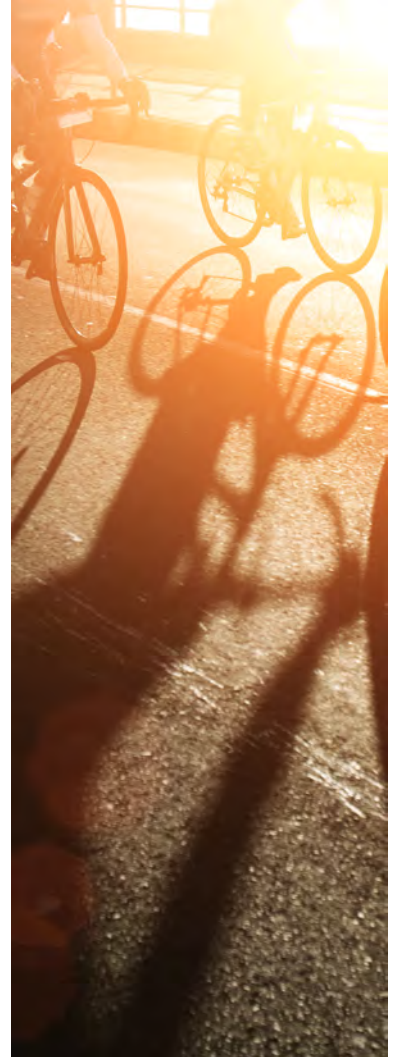

Route 42 Service Change

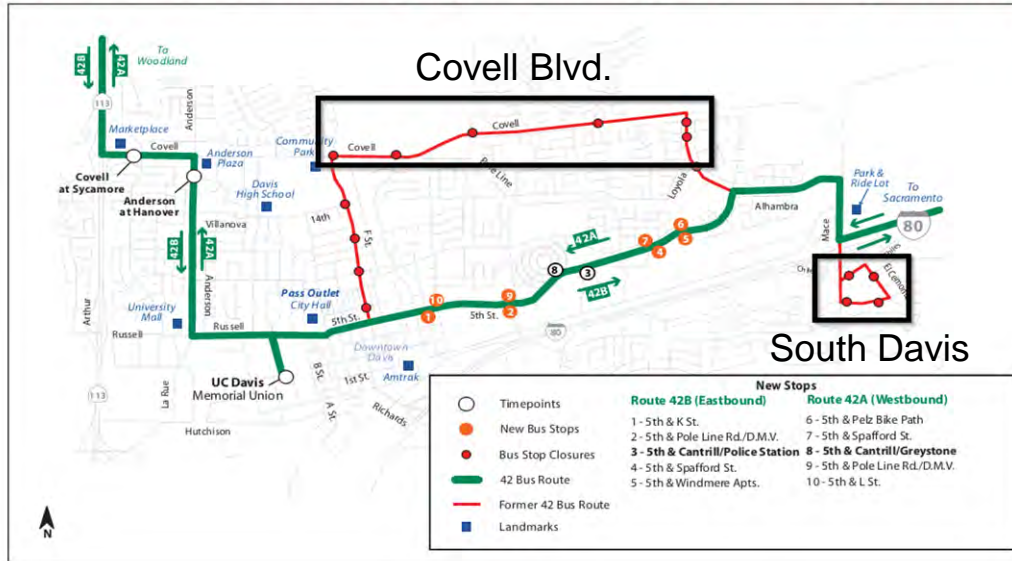
YoloGo Route 42A and 42B Changes

Important Notice

When the YoloGo Route 42 service changes launch (September 19th, 2022), Yolobus will end service to Cowell Blvd. and El Cemente Ave. and reroute the 42 line from Covell Blvd. and F St. to 5th St. Bus stops along the former route will no longer be served. **10** new bus stops will be added along 5th St.



Feedback from Yolobus Riders

Positive Comments:

“Improved Peak hour frequency gives passengers more options for getting to their destination. This is great news!!!”

“I think this (change) will speed up the route and provide multiple points of access”

Concerned Comments:

“Removing of the service on Covell requires residents along Covell to walk to 5th street to catch the bus.”

“Removing of the service from South Davis, Chiles, Mace, Cowell and El Cemente, requires residents to walk over Mace Blvd.”

DRAFT ZERO EMISSION BUS (ZEB) ROLLOUT PLAN DISCUSSION

ZEB Bus Rollout Background

- ▶ In December 2018, the California Air Resources Board (CARB) established the Innovative Clean Transit Regulation (ICT) .
- ▶ Requires all public transit agencies to convert their bus fleet to zero emissions by 2040.
