



Yolo 80 Managed Lanes Update

Overview



- 1. DEIR: Release remains delayed (staff report states 9/6)
 - HQ and D3 putting on final touches
 - Goal to environmentally clear project with express lanes
- 2. Caltrans HQ / D3 / YoloTD consensus to prioritize obligating \$86m INFRA funds
- 3. Caltrans D3 looking at Phase 1 Build Options consistent with Final EIR selected alternative.





Yolo 80 Managed Lanes Update

Overview



Yolo 80 managed lanes / express lanes vision will require multiple phases to complete.

- Phase 1 Build Option may not include tolling
- Caltrans commitment to continue corridor investments toward express lanes future phases.
- Essential component to contiguous megaregion I-80 express lanes facility.
- Consistent with regional transportation policies







Overview

- **1. SACOG Funding:** Continue obligating \$2m for subset of Tolling Advance Planning activities for a Phase 2 project.
 - Continues momentum toward Final EIR project.
- 2. Governance: Continue engaging regional partners in establishing regional tolling JPA.

Staff Recommendation

 Provide feedback on proposed updates to ADA Paratransit Rider Policies, Application and Service Area


Background

- Under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), Yolobus provides door-to-door shuttle service, known as Yolobus Special, for individuals who are unable to use fixed-route service.
- Routes and destinations served by fixed-route transit must also be served by paratransit.
- Individuals must go through an application process before being eligible to use the service.
- Paratransit Policies and Riders Guides were last updated in 2016.

Background

- Since 2020 there has been steady increase in enrollment for Paratransit service, along with complaints regarding the application process.
- Currently over 1,000 registered paratransit riders eligible for service.
- Paratransit ridership has rebounded from COVID more quickly than fixed-route ridership.

Yolobus Special Name Change

 Proposal to Change the paratransit service from Yolobus Special to YoloMobile

Changes to Rider Guide

- Streamlining information to strictly discuss how a rider would interact with paratransit service
- General Formatting (page numbers, table of contents, etc)
- Updating holiday schedule in include state holidays

Changes to Paratransit Application

- Creating a digital application
- Removing redundant questions, or questions that don't directly determine the ADA eligibility criteria
- Clarifying the review Application review window is 21 working days.
- Procedural changes to strengthen verification process and require riders to re-establish eligibility from time to time.

Changes to Paratransit Rider Policy

- Removing punitive language for rider Noshows
- Changes the suspension policy window to restart every 30 days (as opposed to 60 days currently)

Changes to Service Area and Service Times Proposed

Woodland: (Local fare)

*Reducing service times (due to cuts from 210 and 214)

Davis: (Intercity Fare)

*Reducing start times due to cuts to route 220 Service

West Sac: (Local fare)

*Reducing start times due to cuts to route 35 and local service times

Intercity: (Intercity Fare)

*Reducing service times to match coverage of fixed route service

Sacramento: Premium

*Shortening the duration of daily service to match current fixed route service

Winters: Premium

*Operating service hours to match existing Beeline Service

Knights Landing Premium

*Adding Knights Landing as a service Area *Using Beeline Service Hours to match existing service

Background

- Will develop an active transportation plan of multi-use trails that will help address mobility barriers for low-income and minority residents of Yolo County.
- Was awarded \$1.2 million in federal funds from the Rebuilding Americans Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) discretionary grant program.




